

ROCKLANDS NO. 1737

The School District of Rocklands No. 1737 was formed March 27, 1914 by the Rural Municipality of Westbourne and included in the Municipal School District of Glenella No. 1006 by Order-in-Council No. 431/36 dated April 14, 1936. It was situated on 10-20-11 W.P.M. The school opened in January 1915 with eight boys and nine girls registered. May Mayers was the first teacher and the first trustees were Merle Johnston, John Locke and J. Baldwin.
