George Forbes - born at Guelph July 7, 1885, went to Melgund and Hartney schools and to Ontario Agricultural College at Guelph. He farmed E2-6-24 and was married October 27, 1915 to Mary Edith Galbraith who was born November 28, 1892, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. William Henry Galbraith of Hartney. Forbes died March 20, 1970 and Mary lives in Cameron Lodge in Hartney. They had six children -

William Gladstone - married Sarah Ann Moore of Fairfax in October 1933 and farmed at Hartney.

James Morrison came to Lauder to buy the mill from J. A. Chaloner in 1895. His partner was Robert Reid who was probably the father or brother of James' wife, Sarah Reid, whom he married June 23, 1893. She was born at Millbank, Ontario June 23, 1871, daughter of Robert Reid of Perth County and Mary Montgomery. They left Lauder for Edmonton in February 1898. Sarah had been organist in the church for most of the time they were in Lauder.
