She was married to Ernest Fenwick in 1960 and became stepmother to three teenage girls. Ernest is a general contractor. Blanche took courses in Interior Decorating and Child Psychology and taught in the Waller Kindergarten in Fort Garry for five years. She then worked as a security officer for five years for Cox Retail Audits Limited in the Woolco stores. MULLET

The William Mullet family came from Somerset, England in 1821 to Prince Edward county in Ontario by the Bay of Quinte where the Bakers (page 328), Brigden (page 345) and Wood families lived. Three of the Mullet sons married three of the Baker daughters. The children of one of these pairs, Arthur Mullet and Jane Baker, came west. They were Sarah, Alfred Nash, George and Edwin. Sarah married Duncan Wood and lived in the Purple Hill district (Mrs. William Brigden was a daughter). George lived at Purple Hill on the McKim farm for two years and moved on to Willow Bunch, Saskatchewan.

Alfred Nash Mullet, born about 1851, and his wife, Sarah Rogers Brown, came west at least as early as 1889, and bought W23-5-24. They bought N9-5-23 in the 1890s, NE9 at least as early as 1892. They appear to have rented the farms in the fall of 1895 and the family moved to Pickering in January 1896. They returned to the farm, likely to live on N9, about the first of April 1899 and sold W23 to Enos McRoberts in 1902. In April 1903 Alfred was reported to be moving to Battleford, Saskatch-
